Class 5 Trip to Duxford

Last Friday Class 5 had a very interesting and exciting trip to the Imperial War Museum at Duxford.

The historic site offers a unique insight into conflict and over a century of aviation. It was a former RAF fighter station that was used during both the First and Second World Wars. The children were able to get up-close to some of the most famous aircraft in the world, including the Lancaster, the Spitfire, Concorde and Vulcan. The Lancaster is one of the most recognised allied bombers of the Second World War, famous for its role in the Dambusters Raid.
