

FIRST AID SHARING INFORMATION

Taken into account the nature of employees' work, the number of staff and pupils, and the location of the school we have decided to train <u>all</u> staff in First Aid. This ensures that there are enough trained staff to meet requirements and assessed needs, allowing for staff on annual/sick leave or off-site

All Nursery workers have Paediatric First Aid Training.

General First Aid Certificates can be viewed in the Primary and Nursery buildings accordingly.

<u>The appointed staff member for First Aid stock is Miss Tighe</u> she takes charge of first aid arrangements on a regular basis. This includes stock take and replenishment of first aid kits, and a general overview of the equipment. The sports staff liaise with Miss Tighe regarding the stock of the kits that are used for sports fixtures.

We ensure that notices about first aid are displayed in a prominent place, preferably at least one in each building. All staff are responsible for administering First Aid to any child in their care. All staff are first aid trained.

- Skin Closure strips
- Non-latex Hypo-allergenic Gloves

Sports kits also includes

- Ice Packs
- Thermal Blankets
- Slings (various sizes)
